Section 11. Penalties

Any person who fails to comply with any or all of the requirements or provisions of this ordinance or who fails or refuses to comply with any notice, order or direction of the Building Permit Officer or any other authorized employee of the and, shall be guilty of an offense municipality conviction, shall pay a fine to Township of Clifford of not less than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) plus costs of prosecution. In default of such payment, such person shall be imprisoned in county priseon for a period not to exceed ten (10) days. Each day during which any violation of this ordinance continues In addition to the above shall constitute a separate offense. penalties, all other actions are hereby reserved including an action in equity for the proper enforcement of this ordinance. The imposition of a fine or penalty for any violation of, or non-compliance or permit it is continue; and all such persons shall be required to correct or remedy such violations and noncompliances within a reasonable time. Any structure or building constructed, reconstructed, enlarged, or relocated, in non-compliance with this ordinance may be declared by the Board of Supervisors to be a public nuisance and abatable as such.
