Business meeting held on Tuesday, May 9, 2023 at the Clifford Township Municipal building. Chairman Knowlton called the meeting to order at 7:00pm. Mr. Knowlton opened the floor for public comment. Old Business: Motion to modify, post and advertise solar ordinance for public comment again by Mr. Searle 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mr. Knowlton. Elk View drive update: Citation can now be filed. Fee schedule changes reviewed, will be posted/advertised prior to approval. Motor vehicle policy and employee handbook reviewed, no public comment, Motion by Mr. Mr. Knowlton to accept, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mr. Searle. All in favor. Update on 106 property & Dundaff garage. Garage is being cleaned up, processor to serve SR 106 property. Fire Tax rebate update- Phil Price to talk to Fire Company.
