Old Business

<u>Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance (SALDO)</u>. The SALDO has been completed but not in time to be ready to be approved at the Supervisors meeting on January 6th. The Planning Commission will recommend that the SALDO be advertised for the February 2014 Supervisors meeting for hearing and approval.

Minor Subdivision of Lands. Joe Barrett (surveyor) representing Charles Horton, et al, presented maps depicting the subdivision of a 92.3 acre parent lot to create two new lots of 9.435 acres and 10.0 acres from the parent lot along either side of State Route 2008, Airport Road. Request for planning waiver and non-building declaration was submitted as the property is to be dedicated to the express purpose of agricultural use.

Minor-Subdivision of B. Vauter property. Discussion of Susquehanna County Dept. of Planning and Development letter of November 14, 2013. There were four recommendations in the letter that the Planning Commission reviewed and determined that were complete for the current Clifford Twp SALDO and moved to approve the subdivision plan.
