

Clifford Township Supervisors Meeting April 9

Business meeting held on Tuesday April 9, 2013. Chairman Dennis Knowlton called the meeting to order at 7:00pm. Motion to approve the minutes by Mr. Searle, second by Mr. Knowlton. All in favor. Treasurer's report reviewed and will be put on file. List of bill reviewed. Mr. Marcho made a motion to pay the fire co. its portion from the property tax and to take one third of the remainder and pay on the Act 537, sewer loan, seconded by Mr. Searle. All in favor. Mr. Knowlton made a motion to pay bills, seconded by Mr. Marcho. All in favor.

Old Business: Morgan Taylor and Robert Dietz were give letters thanking them for their volunteer work for the township in the recycling program and Mr. Dietz work with the planning commission.

Mr. Knowlton made a motion to award Barhite Excavating the 2013 road bid. Mr. Searle seconded. All in favor.

Att. McGraw drew up a resolution that Lee road is a private road and not Clifford Township's responsibility. Mr. Searle made a motion to adopt the resolution. Mr. Knowlton seconded. All in favor.

Mr. Searle made a motion to have Christy Bennett sworn in as secretary and work agreement papers signed. Mr. Marcho seconded. All in favor. Mr. Searle announced that the township office will be open at least 3 days a week starting in May.

New Business: Bids for the Township Shed floor were opened.
