Business meeting held on Tuesday, August 14, 2018. Chairman Dennis Knowlton called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. Motion to approve the minutes by Mr. Marcho, second by Mr. Searle. All in favor. Mr. Searle spoke about the importance of the Hazard Mitigation Plan and identifying places of potential problems and allocating funds. Mr. Price, EMA, and Constable Munley agreed to work on a plan with the township so services aren't repeated. Mr. Marcho stated flood supplies have been ordered and the emergency generator has been purchased.

Road Master Booths reported visual bridge inspections were done before last night flood. Bridges on Jones Road and Sweatland Road need repair. Mr. Barhite said School House Road is closed due to the storm. Mr. Wilson reported new park trails washed away and he will be applying for an emergency permit for the stream. Mr. Price said to keep track of storm expenses for FEMA.
