Business meeting held on Tuesday, December 14, 2021 at the Clifford Township building. Chairman Knowlton called the meeting to order at 7:00pm. Mr. Knowlton opened the floor for public comment. Nothing offered. Motion by Mr. Knowlton to approve Meeting Minutes 2nd by Mr. Searle. All in Favor. Treasurer's report reviewed and will be put on file. List of bills reviewed.
