Old Business: Update on trucking of material- Contract cannot be changed, however an escalator clause can be added to future contracts. Building removal quote for Inman's Property- Quote from Savino Construction of 5800.00 to remove buildings/equipment work. Commercial Windmill/Solar Panels- Solicitor McGraw reports the Township can't prohibit windmills or solar farms however a standalone ordinance can place regulations on esthetics. Solicitor McGraw will put together a proposal and put on record that Pa has the pending ordinance doctorate, and the Township has begun to create an ordinance.

New Business: Solar Panels for garage: Tennessee Gas Road BondSolicitor McGraw will send out the bond information/paperwork. Welch Hill Road- Motion advertise for Welch Hill Road pave project by Mr. Searle 2nd by Mr. Knowlton. Solar Installation Bid-to begin with previous approval to use ARP funds to pay for project. Daycare- Scholars in Training will be leaving Township Building, Ages & Stages Child Care Center looking to fill the spot. Motion to Increase Vehicle Mileage — from 58.5 cents to 62.5 cents as with IRS standards, no comment from floor, Motion by Mr. Searle 2nd by Mr. Knowlton.
