

Clifford Township Supervisors Meeting June 11

Business meeting was held on Tuesday June 11, 2013. Chairman Dennis Knowlton called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. Motion to approve the minutes by Mr. Knowlton, seconded by Mr. Searle. All in favor. Treasurer's report reviewed and will be put on file. List of bills reviewed. Mr. Knowlton made a motion to pay all bills, seconded by Mr. Searle. All in favor.

Old Business: Bids for garage floor were discussed and Mr. Knowlton put them on hold until they decide what to do with the bids in light that the floor was measured wrong.

The Great American Cleanup was a success. Mr. Searle would like to have a 2nd cleanup in the fall.

Sewer loan is being paid on and Mr. Searle thinks it will be paid off before interest rates go up.

Mr. Marcho made a motion to have the township property surveyed, seconded by Mr. Searle. All in favor.

Solicitor, McGraw, was asked to send another letter for the removal of trailers on Rt. 106. Attorney McGraw send out letters to neighboring township but has not heard back from them about contributing to fire protection insurance.

Road Report: Mr. Marcho said the dirt roads were almost done except for a few places that might need dust control. Next project will be cleaning out the ditches along Elkview Road and putting up road signs.

Tax Collector: Mr. Phillips reported that property taxes should be pretty much completed by the end of June.

Fire Company: Mr. Turner reported 24 fire calls for the month and 19 medical for a total of 43.
