

Clifford Township Supervisors Meeting October 13, 2015

Business meeting held on Tuesday October 13, 2015. Chairman Dennis Knowlton called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. Motion to approve the minutes by Mr. Knowlton, second by Mr. Searle. All in favor. Treasurer's report reviewed and will be put on file. List of bills reviewed. Mr. Searle made a motion to pay bills, except Clifford Auto, seconded by Mr. Knowlton. All in favor. Mr. Searle made a motion to pay Clifford Auto, seconded by Mr. Knowlton. All in favor. Mr. Marcho abstained due to potential conflict of interest.

Old Business: Solicitor Joseph McGraw reported that the Credit card Ordinance was advertised for 30 days and asked for public comments, no comments was made so Mr. McGraw asked for a vote. Mr. Knowlton made a motion to accept the Credit Card Ordinance. Seconded by Mr. Searle. All in favor.

Solicitor Joseph McGraw reported that the Land Use Ordinance was advertised for 30 days and asked for public comments. Mr. Marcho asked if a copy would be sent to the assessment office. Mr. Knowlton, Mr. Searle and Mr. Marcho decided for now, to keep the information in house. With no change in the law as written Mr. McGraw asked for a vote. Mr. Knowlton made a motion to accept the Land Use Ordinance. Seconded by Mr. Searle. All in favor.

Mr. Searle made a motion to give \$15,000.00 to the Clifford Fire Co. for equipment for the new rescue truck and \$10,000.00 to support the ambulance. Seconded by Mr. Knowlton. All in favor. All funds to be taken from the Act 13 fund.

New Business: Mr. Knowlton made a motion to donate \$50.00 to EMHR dinner. Seconded by Mr. Searle. All in favor.

Mr. Searle made a motion to wave the cost of the building permit and to pay for the sheetrock for the bathrooms up at the children's garden. Seconded by Mr. Marcho. All in favor.

Mr. Searle made a motion to have Mr. Shigo (building inspector) check on a possible code violation on a property at Crystal Lake pending on Mr. Shigo excepting the job. Seconded by Mr. Knowlton. All in favor.

Tax Collector: Mr. Phillips reported he collected \$521.00 in real estate and \$43.00 in fire protection. \$19491.00 in real estate and \$1626.00 in Fire protection yet to be collected.

Fire Co: Mr. Turner reported the fire co. responded to well over 50 calls last month.
