

Clifford Township Supervisors Meeting October 8, 2013

Business meeting held on Tuesday October 8, 2013. Chairman Dennis Knowlton called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. Motion to approve the minutes by Mr. Knowlton, second by Mr. Marcho. All in favor. Treasurer's report reviewed and will be put on file. List of bills reviewed. Mr. Marcho made a motion to pay bills, seconded by Mr. Knowlton. All in favor.

Mr. Marcho made a motion to approve the minutes for the September Meeting after explaining that Barhite was the only one to turn in a bid to plow the township roads. The bid was awarded to Barhite Excavating. Mr. Knowlton seconded. All in favor.

Old Business: Discussion about the trailers on 106 and two properties on 2012 was put on hold because Solicitor McGraw was not in attendance. Debbie McWhirr made a formal complaint of garbage being dumped on the property next to hers. Solicitor Napa will have Solicitor McGraw look into the matter.

Road Report: Mr. Marcho stated that cinders have been received and Salt will be delivered soon. Mr. Marcho said that Barhite was going over roads and doing touchups before winter. Ditch work was done on Welch Hill.

Tax Collector: Harry Phillips reported that \$899.00 in real estate taxes was collected and \$75.00 in fire tax. There is still \$18944.00 in real estate and \$1579.00 in fire tax to be collected.

Planning Commission: Mr. Clementoni reported that the Planning Commission and Advisory Committee was ready to submit the finished Comprehensive Plan to the supervisors for review. He asked that copies be sent to neighboring communities and that on December 10th a hearing be held if the supervisors accept the plan. Mr. Clementoni said the SALDO is in the final draft.

Fire Report: Mr. Phillips reported that they had 26 fire rescue and 24 EMS calls for a total of 50 calls. They assisted on 13 calls and had 2 companies assist them. There has been 462 calls to date.

Alliance: Mr. Marcho announced that the Christmas celebration will be on the first Friday in December (12/6/2013) and there will be fireworks display.
