New Business: Mr. Searle made a motion to purchase land from Mr. Pettinato for \$15000.00 along state route 2012 for a back way into the recreation area. The property would measure about 50' by 509'. Seconded by Mr. Knowlton. All in favor. Mr. Searle stated that all properties bought for the recreation area is being paid for by Act 13 money.
